Step 1: Connect with a Club

Ask your school counselor, community leaders, or search online for a local Leo Club.

Contact your local Lions Club if a Leo Club doesn't exist yet—they can help you start one!

Step 2: Confirm Your Age Group

Alpha Leos (12–18 years old)

Omega Leos (18–30 years old)

Step 3: Submit an Application

Fill out a Leo Club Membership Application (provided by the local club).

If under 18, you may need parental permission.

Step 4: Get Oriented

Attend your first Leo Club meeting.

Learn about ongoing service projects and upcoming events.

Meet other Leos and club advisors.

Step 5: Serve and Lead

Participate in service projects, fundraisers, and leadership training.

Volunteer to help organize events or lead a team.
